Emergency Descent Training



OVERVIEW

This nationally recognised training provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to safely perform rescue and controlled-descent escape procedures from an Elevating Work Platform (EWP).

The training is intended for workers who operate, supervise, or support EWP activities and need to respond effectively to emergency situations while complying with workplace health and safety requirements.

This course consists of the following units of competencies:

- **UETDRMP015** Perform elevated work platform controlled descent escape
- **UETDRMP016** Perform elevated work platform rescue

CONTENT

This training covers emergency response and rescue procedures for elevated work platforms (EWPs), including hazard identification, risk assessment, safety controls, and incident management. Participants will learn how to inspect and use rescue, retrieval, and descent equipment, perform controlled descent escapes, rescue personnel using approved retrieval systems, assess casualties, complete post-rescue procedures, and meet site security, communication, and incident reporting requirements.

REQUIREMENTS

A copy of Statement of Attainment for 'HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation' which is less than twelve months old must be provided to enrol in this course.

Participants must have the physical capability to meet the performance criteria of these units, including fitting a harness, climbing into an EWP, working at height, attaching a descent device, climbing out of the basket, descending safely to the ground, and manually handling a rescue dummy.
