TLILIC0005 Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more)



OVERVIEW

This nationally recognised course will provide you with the knowledge and skills you will need to operate elevating work platforms which extend to 11 metres or more and attain your WorkSafe High Risk Work Licence. Equip-Safe will send your application to WorkSafe. An interim High Risk Work Licence will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

CONTENT

This course covers conducting risk assessments, inspecting safety equipment, demonstrating the safe usage of the EWP, and proper shutdown procedures. The theoretical components include legal requirements, workplace hazards, safety equipment inspections, operation checks, understanding compliance plates, and emergency rescue planning.

REQUIREMENTS

You must be 18 years of age or older, possess reasonably good reading, writing and numeracy ability, and provide appropriate identification as specified in the WorkSafe Applicant Guide.

One day assessment only for experienced operators

You must be a skilled operator and have previously held an Elevated Work Platform >11 (class WP) High Risk Work Licence in Australia, and be able to demonstrate operation following safe work practices. Equip-Safe will verify your eligibility for this course and provide you with a declaration to complete at time of enrolment. Completing of pre-course reading and an activity book is required prior to undertaking the course.
